Heads Up	New Building Code STANDATA have been released by Alberta Municipal Affairs.
Details	<p>Building/Fire STANDATA:</p> <p>14-BCV-010 <i>Interconnected Smoke Alarms</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Allows the utilization of wireless interconnection technology. <p>14-BCV-011/14-FCV-012 <i>Door Release Hardware</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Allows for the use of electromagnetic locks and one additional release device, with some restrictions, for Group B, Division 2 and Division 3 occupancies. <p>Electrical STANDATA:</p> <p>LEG-ECR-2 [rev 25] <i>Section 2 – Electrical Systems Equipment</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Defines “certification body” and “inspection body” and reviews the Canadian Electrical Code sections for approved equipment. <p>CEC-46 <i>Section 46 – Emergency power supply, unit equipment, exit signs, and life safety systems</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Clarifies the allowable circuit configurations for exit signs and the activation of emergency lighting when supplied by unit equipment.
